This month's character pillar is: **Citizenship.**

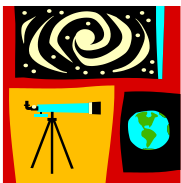
What's been happening in our classroom this week:

Additionally, this week we learned about time and how to read an analog and digital clock. The students' growth is wonderful! ☺



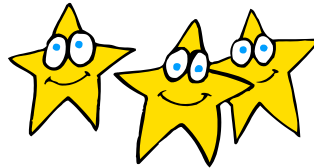
